Aleksandr Žedeljov, also known by the artistic name Faershtein, is a multifaceted musician, composer, and producer. He has collaborated with various ensembles and artists, composed chamber and film music, created scores for fashion and theater performances, participated in media exhibitions, and developed sound installations. Žedeljov is the producer and creator behind projects such as Modulshtein, Triophonix, and Audiokinetica, along with other art endeavors. He has released nine albums and has performed at numerous music festivals and events across Europe.

From 2001 to 2006, he studied jazz guitar under Mart Soo at the Georg Ots Music School in Tallinn. Between 2012 and 2015, he pursued studies in audiovisual creation at the Estonian Academy of Music and Theatre, where he also studied composition under Galina Grigorieva, graduating with a bachelor's degree in composition in 2016.

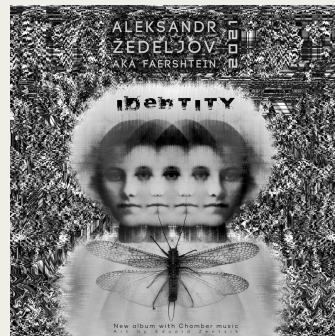
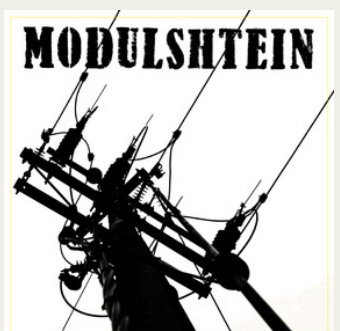
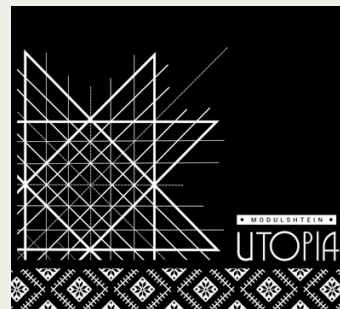
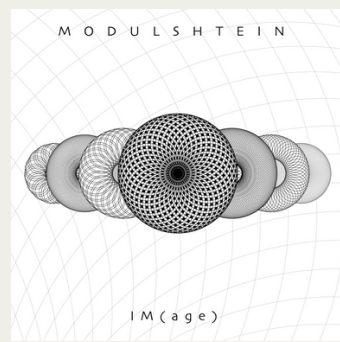

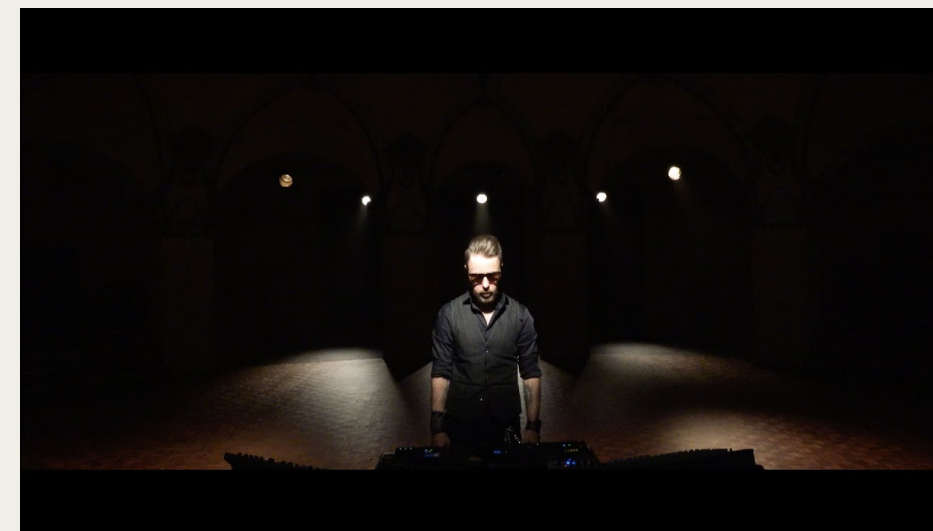


MODULSHEIN

TRIOPHONIX

Triophonix blends jazz, electronic soundscapes, and ethnic styles, creating an intriguing mix where jazz, ethnic instruments, and electronic music come together to craft original compositions with a fresh and experimental edge. Most of its music is born live through an improvisational approach, giving each performance a unique spontaneity.

IDEM

IDEM is an audiovisual performance, which takes us back to the source of being, when the comfort zone was bordered with fire and beyond it was a frighteningly unknown and dangerous strange world, where relationships had to be fought out. From that moment, civilisation started to emerge, needing rules and regulations. Today, however, there are so many of them that people are confused and cannot find a solution or a way out. The production touches on identification, co-existence and adaptation in the society in a number of ways. Complicated questions starting with culture and routine and ending with how the same conditions may influence an entire country or even a continent. Original music is performed by a string orchestra. Music is written by composer Aleksandr Zhedeljov.
Audiokinetica is a collective of creative, active and energetic people that creates original performances, executes audiovisual and kinetic projects, makes music, theatre and other forms of art.

MECHANICAL PIANO consists of chamber music non-verbal theatre-action and high end multimedia technology by the young international ensemble Audiokinetica led by Aleksandr Žedeljov. It's inspired by the first novel by Kurt Vonnegut, Player Piano from 1952 and deals with essential issues of fate — about the power balance between technology and humanity, about the way we are overflowed by information. The performance places music as a suggested a tool for survival.

ALICE

"Alice" – live performance in **Tallinn (2011)**
Alice is a unique mixture of creative ingredients like contemporary choreography, jazz music, art video, animation, VJ set and shadow theatre. All spiced up with a little bit of improvisation, simple magic and rolled into something what we call a real-time live performance. Alice's creators are: MTÜ Fat Snail, MTÜ HeliTelg, Max Golomidov, Olga Privis and Aleksandr Žedeljov. Our performance is inspired by Lewis Carol's novel Alice's Adventures in Wonderland, still it is not strictly close to the original text.
Our Alice is contemporary girl, who follows the White Rabbit and finds herself on a journey to the unknown land of dreams, miracles and magic. Live performance will premiere in June 2011 in Russian Theatre of Estonia, Tallinn. Alice is a project that is not connected to a certain indoor stage conditions. Stay tuned for a series of surprise events in the most unexpected spots of Tallinn.
